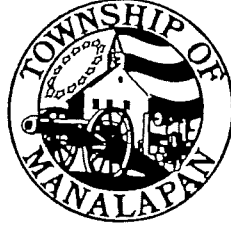

ADOPT-A-SPOT/ROAD GUIDELINES, RULES, AND INFORMATION

- By “adopting” either a public spot or road around Manalapan, you are pledging to do at least two (2) cleanups per year.
- It is your responsibility to maintain your site and keep it clean.
- You must wear gloves and vests when performing cleanups, but everything you need (including these items) will be provided to you by the Township by funding through an annual Clean Communities Grant that they are given by the State of New Jersey.
- You will need to use specifically colored bags, with one color for recyclables, and one color for trash, respectively.
- The Township will collect any bagged litter after a given clean-up.
- You don’t need to buy your own/use your own supplies.
- Once a registered group completes their clean-up they will have a sign recognizing their work in that location, and will also be recognized at a public meeting of the Township Committee.
- By “adopting” either a spot or a road and taking the measures necessary to maintain its cleanliness/make it cleaner, you will be helping keep our town clean and contributing in keeping the Township of Manalapan as “A Great Place to Live”.
