

- Rohypnol
 - Rohypnol or Flunitrazepam is a central nervous depressant. It is odorless, tasteless, and dissolves into liquid. Because this has caused it to be used as a date rape drug manufacturers have created green tablets that contain blue dye in order to make the drug more detectable. The original tablets are still available. (cesar)
 - **Street names:**
 - **Uses:** Rohypnol is most commonly used orally by swallowing or chewing the pills, or allowing them to dissolve in one's mouth. It can also be crushed into a powder to be snorted or spilled onto other drugs. (cesar)
 - **Short-Term Physical Effects:** Rohypnol can result in a relaxed feeling, decreased blood pressure, muscle relaxation, drowsiness, memory impairment, dizziness, headaches, nightmares, confusion, tremors, disinhibition, excitability or aggressive behavior, and antegrade amnesia. (cesar)
